# Solve: what judges are looking for

Judges will be looking at how the team considered:

- Local context and cultural awareness
- Feasibility and accessibility
- Alignment to the Solve challenge briefs to develop the best solution
- The format – follow the requirements stated on Page 2

Criteria	Description	Score Range
Local context and cultural awareness	How well does the solution consider the local context, including cultural, environmental, and societal factors? How culturally appropriate is the solution? Does the team demonstrate understanding of the target community's unique needs?	1 – 5 (1 = minimal, 5 = excellent)
Feasibility and accessibility	Is the solution realistic, implementable and achievable within the scope of the challenge? Is it cost-effective and sustainable? Could it be scaled up? Is the solution accessible and does it address the needs and preferences of diverse community members/users?	1 – 5 (1 = not feasible, 5 = highly feasible)
Alignment to the Solve challenge briefs	How well does the proposed solution align with the challenge briefs? Does the team demonstrate a clear understanding of the problem and objectives, and does the solution directly address the challenge?	1 – 5 (1 = poor alignment, 5 = perfect alignment)
Adherence to requirements	Did the team follow all the required guidelines stated on Page 2 of the submission instructions? This includes submission format, specific requirements, and deadlines.	1 – 5 (1 = non-compliant, 5 = fully compliant)



# Tips

- Please do not exceed:
  - 1,000-word report (excluding appendices, which should not exceed five pages)
  - A3 poster/ board
  - 5-minute video
  - 10 slides – title and end slides are excluded
- If you choose to do a PowerPoint, please refrain from including animations, music, audio, or embedded videos, as these elements may significantly increase the file size.
- Remember: quantity does not equal quality! Teams that do more than one submission for each category do not necessarily do better.
- Remember: your submission is the only way that WaterAid will be assessing your team – so whatever method you choose, make sure you wow the judges!
