



Squeaky Clean FUNDRAISING JOURNEY

1. OUR STRATEGY

We planned one major fundraiser event — **Dunk**Ya Boss Breakfast BBQ at 5W Western Treatment
Plant (WTP) Project. Our strategy involved
collaboration of BMD staff, our client, designer,
subcontractors to ensure a strong turnout and
support for WaterAid's mission in Tarawai Island,
Papua New Guinea. Setting a clear fundraising
target of \$5,000 and raising awareness of
WaterAid's work were key objectives, and our
collaborative approach was fundamental in
driving the success of the fundraising event.

2. SEED FUND USE

The seed fund initial amount was \$750 and was used to hire a dunk tank at the fundraising event so our 12 courageous bosses could take the plunge into 1700 litres of cold water.

The dunk tank hire cost was \$1,128 and BMD donated the remaining balance of \$378.

3. OUR COMMUNICATION

The event was planned well in advance and organised, the communication kicked off with individual and personalised phone calls made to our client, designer and subcontractors regarding their involvement.

Communications included internal and external emails with accompanying promotional posters, calendar invites, posters displayed on project walls and social media promotion on BMD Group LinkedIn, tagging our delivery partners. Internal Yammer updates were provided to all BMD staff working across the entire business.

We also utilised the invaluable support from BMD's General Manager — VIC/SA/TAS and CEO by tapping into their business updates and utilised the morning toolbox talks at Western Treatment Plant project as well.

In the lead up to the event, our 5W WTP project team reached out to our valued subcontractors and suppliers driving fundraising efforts. The donations came splashing in immediately.

3. COMMUNICATION Cont.

To make sure that no one missed out, especially those who were working in other states and had generously donated, we set up a live stream of our 12 bosses taking the plunge into the 1700 litre tank of water. This way, all staff who contributed to the cause could witness the moment and feel part of the event, no matter where they were located. It was fantastic to see our 12 bosses coming together to support this worthy cause!

2. OUR ENGAGEMENT

5. FUNDRAISING EVENT

BMD donated the breakfast BBQ food at the event, hosting up to 200 employees. The cost of the food was \$1,100.30. Our Squeaky Clean team rolled up their sleeves, and rallied behind one another, to ensure all allocated tasks were smoothly and successfully completed ensuring the event went as planned.

Two chocolate door prizes and a charcoal spit roaster including barbeque items were donated by two of BMD's suppliers. The charcoal spit roaster was raffled off on the day raising another successful donation of \$369.25. The door prizes were given to two staff for their attendance at the event.

We started off the challenge with a fundraising target of \$5,000. We concluded the challenge on top of the Winnovators leaderboard with a super impressive fundraising amount of
